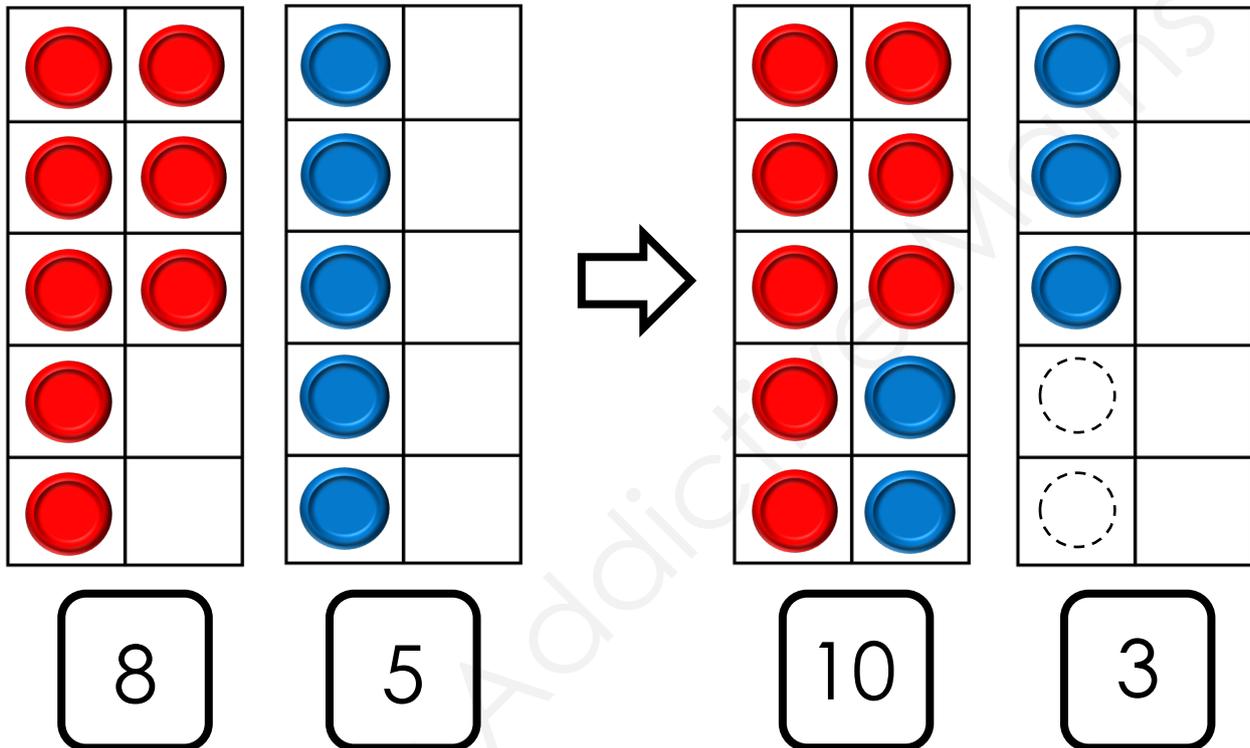

### Adding by making 10

What is  $8 + 5$ ?



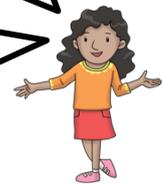
$$8 + 5 = 13$$

8 + 2 = 10  
10 + 3 = 13

8 + 5 is equal to 10 + 3.

$$8 + 2 = 10$$

$$10 + 3 = 13$$

Fill in the blanks.

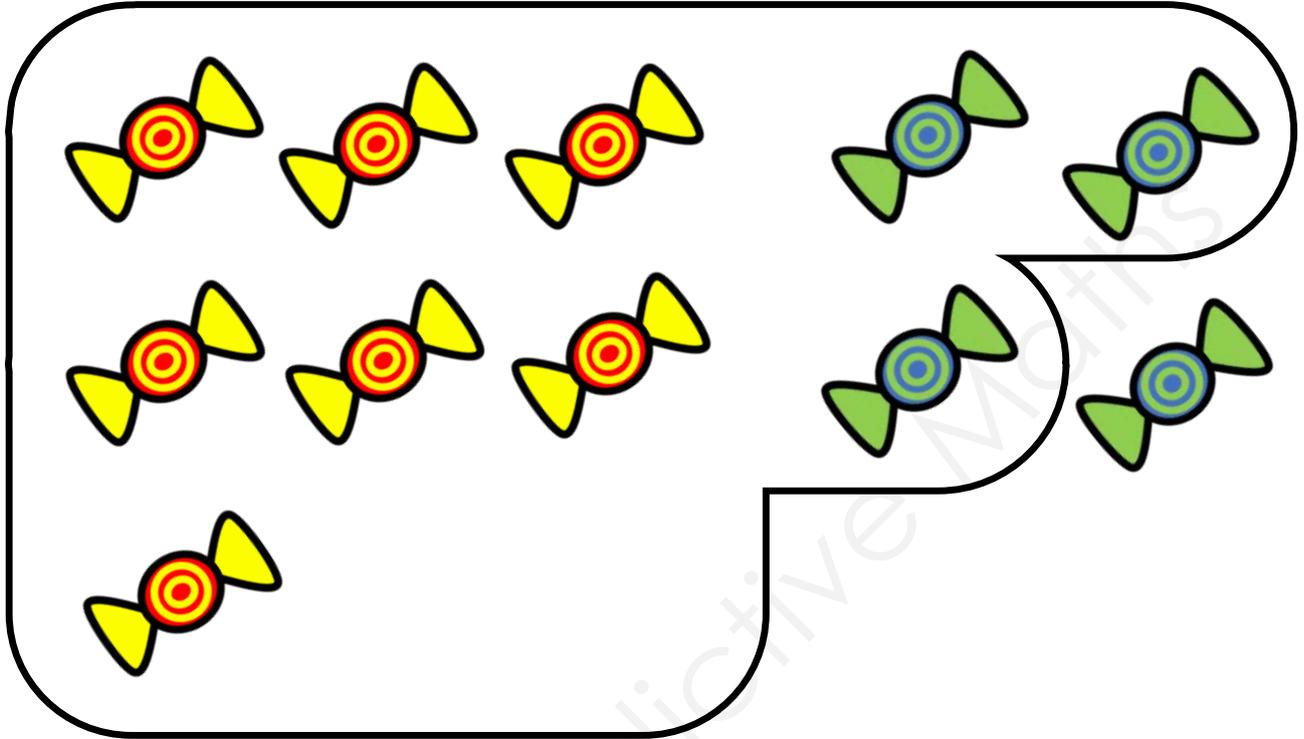
